Speedy SDMO's Head to Belfast Continental Market



Speedy - the UK's leading provider of equipment rental and support services - has invested £3.6 million in a fleet of generators from SDMO Energy.

More than 200 power generation products have been purchased and will be distributed across Speedy's depot network. The investment gives Speedy the largest fleet of generators that comply with EU stage 3A emissions in the UK. Stage 3A is now a legal requirement that all manufacturers must now adhere to and if anyone is caught producing non-conforming mobile product, it can lead to a prison sentence.

Some of the first units arrived in Speedy Belfast and eight 60's, 80's and 100's went straight to the Continental Market in the grounds of Belfast City Hall.

The new generators - which range in size from 80-500kVA - are more fuel efficient

and cost effective for users and each features an external control panel to improve safety and accuracy.

The fuel tanks are fully bunded with leakage detection and all sizes are easy to manoeuvre as they have been fitted with fork lift pockets and crane lifting pegs.

Andy Connor, supply chain director at Speedy, said: "Generators are essential in construction projects but with rising fuel costs and increasing environmental concerns they can be expensive to operate.

"Our customers need more fuel efficient units so we teamed up with SDMO to develop these state-of-the-art generators which are compliant with our sustainability strategy, One Plan.
